What is a Travelogue?

A travelogue is a written account of a journey or trip, describing places, experiences, and feelings.

Prepare a Travelogue on a scrapbook.

Project Instructions

Title: My Travel Adventure

Students will create a travelogue (8–10 sentences or 1–2 pages) based on:

A real trip they went on

OR

An imaginary journey (to a hill station, beach, forest, or even space)

What to Include:

- 1) Place visited (Where did you go?)
Journey details (How did you travel?)
- 2) Things you saw (Nature, people, food, etc.)
Activities (What did you do there?)
- 3) Feelings/Experience (How did you feel?)
Conclusion (Would you like to visit again?)

1) Number Art (Place Value Chart)

Draw a tree and write a 6-digit number on top.

Break the number into place values (Lakhs, Thousands, Hundreds, Tens, Ones).

Show each part on branches using colours.

2) Geometry Art (Shapes Drawing)

Make a beautiful drawing (house, garden, robot, etc.) using:

Circle , Square , Rectangle , Triangle

Colour and label each shape.

3) Measures

Measure 5 objects at home (table, book, pencil, etc.)

Write their lengths in cm or m.

4) Maths Around me (Photo/Draw Activity)

Draw or paste pictures showing:

Shapes in real life

Patterns in nature

Example: Sun = Circle, Door = Rectangle

5) Create your own word problems.

Make maths story problems based on:

- Money, Time
- Addition/Subtraction
- Solve them neatly

Instructions:

- ✓ Do work neatly in coloured A4 size paper
- ✓ Make it creative and attractive
- ✓ Arrange it in a file
- ✓ Make creative front page

Theme: Green Plants & Creativity

Activity 1: Grass Head Doll

- Let's grow your own funny green "hair"!
- Materials Needed , Old socks , Soil , Rubber band , Sketch pens / marker
- Grass seeds (or coriander/mustard seeds if not available)

Instructions:

- 1) Take an old sock and fill it with soil.
- 2) Add grass seeds (or coriander/mustard seeds) on top.
- 3) Tie the open end with a rubber band to make a round shape.
- 4) Draw a funny face on the sock using sketch pens.
- 5) Place it in a small bowl and sprinkle water daily.
- 6) Watch the "hair" (grass) grow in a few days!

Tip:

- ✓ You can even give your doll a name and style its "hair"!

Activity 2: Seed Art (Creative Work)

- Let's create a beautiful art using seeds!
- Materials Needed:
- Seeds (rajma, chana, rice, etc.)
- Chart paper , Glue , Pencil

Instructions:

- 1) Draw a simple picture on chart paper (tree or flower).
- 2) Apply glue on the drawing carefully.
- 3) Paste different seeds to fill the design.
- 4) Let it dry properly.
- 5) Decorate your chart neatly.

Tip:

- ✓ Use different seeds to add colours and texture to your artwork!

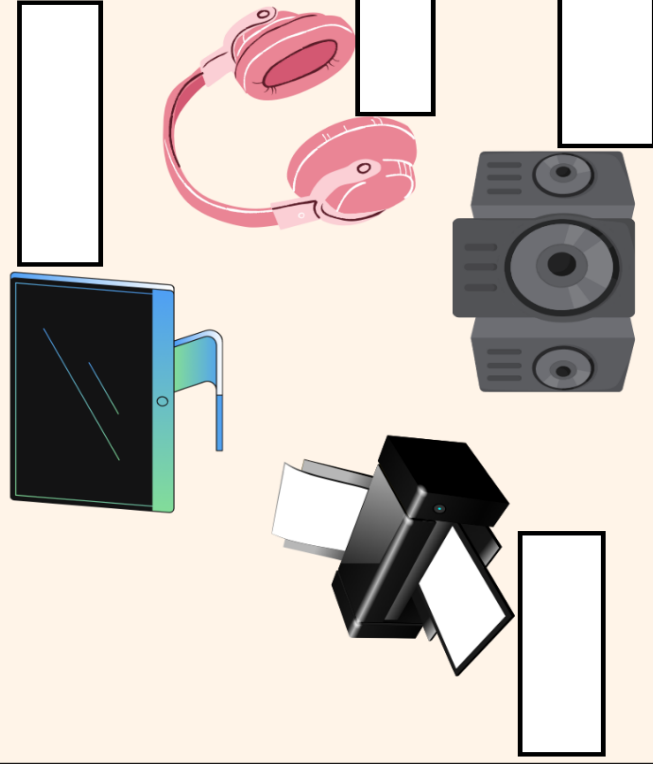

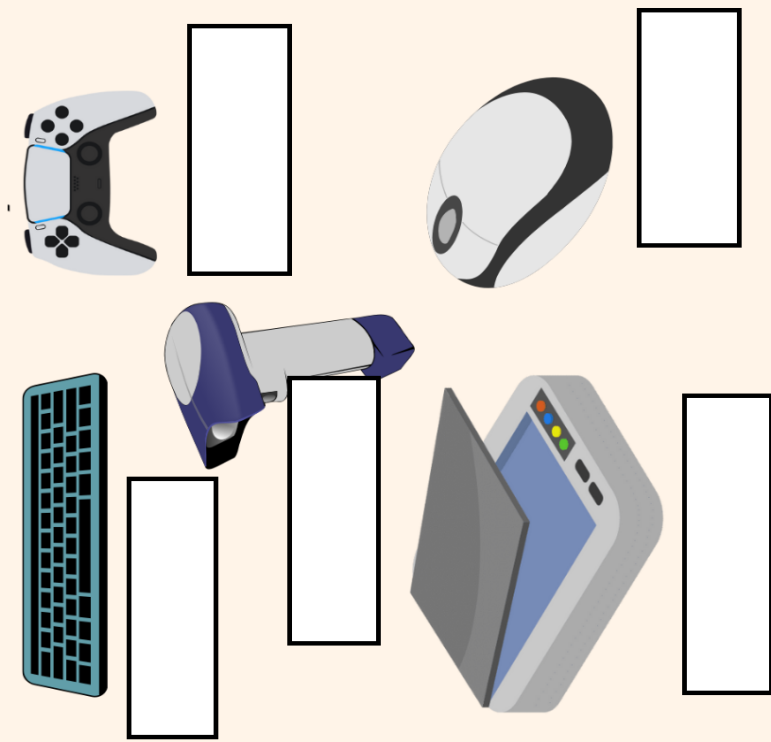
