Answer the following questions.

1. Find the sum of all 9 numbers in the highlighted square. Now, multiply the middle number (21) by 9. What do you observe? Does this work for any other 3×3 square on the calendar?
2. Look at any column (e.g., 7, 14, 21, 28). What is the rule or "common difference" between these numbers? Why do you think this specific number appears in every column?
3. Add the three numbers in the horizontal middle line ($20 + 21 + 22$) and the three numbers in the vertical middle column ($14 + 21 + 28$). Compare the results.
4. Add the numbers of the two diagonals:
 - a) Diagonal 1: $13 + 21 + 29 = ?$
 - b) Diagonal 2: $15 + 21 + 27 = ?$

What is the relationship between these sums and the middle number?

5. If we call the middle number 'n', how would you write the number directly above it and the number directly below it using n?

 - Awareness and wellbeing
 - Healthy living
